

You plan on heading to Avignon directly from the Marseille Airport (MRS)

Direct Trains from MRS to Avignon TGV will be by LOCAL TRAIN ONLY (TER)
You will leave from the Vitrolles Airport Marseille Train Station

Below is the **Saturday (June 14th) Schedule** for the Direct Train w/ cost of €21 pp which will get you to the Avignon TGV station in time for the Transfer bus.

NOTE: If you plan to travel directly to Avignon prior to the start date of our tour directly from the airport, you can select trains going to **Avignon Centre *instead of the TGV station*** when you go to make your train purchase. But either station will work {**Avignon Centre station is closer to the city center**}.

From the MRS Airport you will need to take a bus to **Vitrolles Marseille Provence Airport train station**. This bus leaves out of bus station platform #5 (see next page) and takes about 5 -10 minutes. The average wait time is about 10-15 minutes for the bus to arrive. **(NOTE: this is a free bus with your prepaid train ticket & You will need to take the Le Bus line 13, However be prepared to pay 1.20 euro to the driver via cash or credit card, if needed, if it is no longer free)**

Where to buy your train ticket (**highly recommended that you buy these in advance**)

- Click on the SNCF-connect website: <https://www.sncf-connect.com/en-en/> or use the SNCF Connect app.
- In the Search box, where it says Search for short or long distance trips and much more...
- Type in the following:

****For Destination:** type in **Avignon TGV**, then select **Avignon TGV** from menu.

Once the page opens up with Arrival at Avignon TGV, fill in the **Departure box** with **Aeroport Marseille** and then pick **Vitrolles Marseille-Provence Airport**

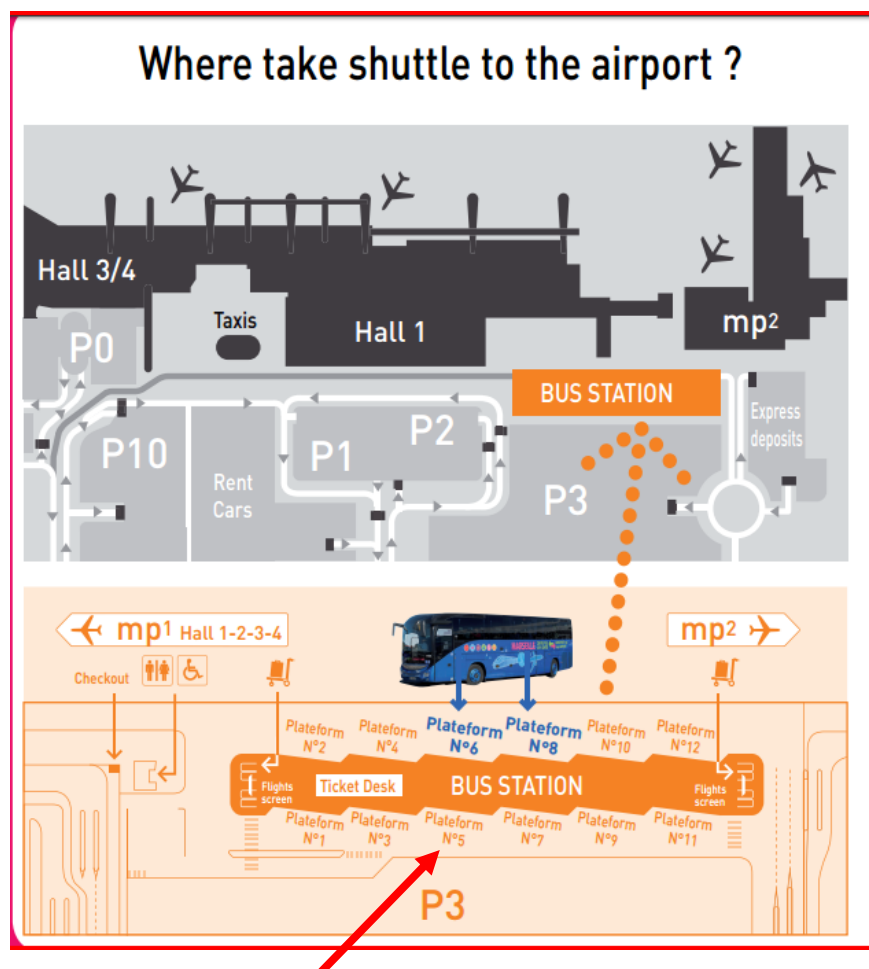
(make sure you see the work **"Station"** listed above the location when choose from the dropdown menu)

- Add in **Date and Time** (in the Outbound box) and if you are returning to this same station, you can check a roundtrip ticket.
- **Under Filter by:** Tap on **Travelling via**, then type in **Avignon** and then pick **Avignon Centre** from the dropdown menu
- If you need to add a Second Traveler do this now by clicking on "Add":
After you are done with the Travelers, Then click on **"See Prices"**
- To see more time options, you might need to click on **"display previous journeys."**
- Then follow all props to make your purchase.

** if you are traveling directly to Avignon prior to the start date of our tour from the airport you can use the **Avignon Centre** station instead, as it is very close to the city center @ 900 yards.

Note: TER trains just have one fixed price fare. These tickets are valid for one journey on any train leaving until midnight on the day after you validate it in the little composter machines on the platform. So if you purchase the 11:58 train ticket, you can use that on any train that day. Also there are no seat reservations on these trains , seats are first come first served.

How to Find the Le Bus Line #13 at the Airport



Free Bus (with train ticket) to Vitrolles Marseille Airport Train Station Can Be Found Here (Platform 5)

Please note: the shuttle buses to Super Eco parking also depart from platform N°5, alternating with **Le Bus line 13**, which will go to the **Vitrolles Marseille-Provence Airport TER train station** from the **Marseille Provence Airport**. Please check the bus destination before boarding.

Look for Le Bus line 13, there is usually one stop between the airport and the train station.
