- We will be starting the class with the **Belgian Style Strong Pale Ale**. Belgian Style Strong Pale Ales tend to have a very large foamy head, so you might want to make sure you have a large enough glass to accommodate the beer and the mousse!
- We suggest that you use a clean, unfrosted / non-chilled glass for each beer.
