



Arrival and Departure Information Bella Tuscany Tour May 31 -June 8, 2026

ARRIVAL DETAILS:

Please note that you will be responsible for making your own way to the **25hours Hotel Florence Piazza San Paolino** (Piazza di S. Paolino, 1, 50123 Firenze), on **May 31, 2026 by 16:30** when we start our tour with a **Welcome Toast**.

We highly suggest you arrive in Italy at least a day before the tour starts to allow for flight or train delays, etc... however, we realize vacation time can be limited. So, if you are arriving the morning of the tour, we advise you allow a minimum of 5-7 hours between your landing time and arrival at the hotel **25hours Hotel Florence** to allow you enough time to go through passport control, collect your luggage, take the taxi or train from your Italian Hotel/Airport to the Hotel to arrive by 4:00pm.

- Whether you're arriving in **Florence, Pisa** or in **Rome** you will find details below on how to arrive via train.

Arrival at Amerigo Vespucci Airport (Florence Airport) – FLR

- **Take a Taxi to 25hours Hotel Florence Piazza San Paolino:** About 30 min (10 km). **(BEST BET)**
- **Take Tram #2** – There is a tram just outside the entrance of the airport that goes near the Firenze Santa Maria Novella train station, which is about a 10-minute walk (600 yards) to the Hotel. **HOWEVER, luggage cannot be over 40 pounds** & with a second piece of luggage you will need to purchase an extra ticket. Let me know if you want to do this and I will send you more info.

Departure Information from Tenuta Guardastelle (June 8th)

We have arranged a transfer to Florence, departing at **9:30 AM** from Tenuta Guardastelle. (Travel time is about 1 hour). We will 1st stop at the **Florence Airport (FLR)**, Estimated arrival 10:30; then at the **Firenze Santa Maria Novella Train Station**, Estimated arrival at 11:00. Guests staying in Florence can get off at the train station and then take a taxi or walk to your Florence hotel.

What you should know about using UBER in Italy: The best taxi apps in Italy are generally **FreeNow**, **itTaxi**, **AppTaxi** and **WeTaxi**, as they work with official taxis, offer upfront pricing, and allow in-app payment, with **FreeNow** and **itTaxi** being most prominent in major cities like Rome and Milan, while **AppTaxi** is also popular in places like Florence; **Uber operates but often uses private drivers (Uber Black) and may add surcharges**
